

## **HOW TO REACH THE CNR BUILDING IN GENOVA, VIA DE MARINI 6 BY CAR:**

- Exit the A10 motorway at “GENOVA OVEST”.
- After the Genova Ovest toll station, keep to the right-hand lane and after approximately 300 m take the downhill ramp on the right signposted as “SAMPIERDARENA” and “ACQUARIO”. At the bottom of the ramp you’ll come to a set of traffic lights: here turn left, following the signs for “Terminal Crociere” – “Imbarco Traghetto” (cruise ship and ferry terminal). Make sure not to go up the ramp signposted as “Sopraelevata”, which is right opposite the traffic lights across the main road, as this is a flyover that will take you to the other side of town.
- After turning, continue straight along the main road until you come to a wide downhill bend around a high-rise office block. At the traffic lights at the bottom of the bend you have to turn right.
- The road runs under a flyover bridge and then comes to a roundabout where you keep going straight ahead while moving across to the left lane. Just after the roundabout is a set of traffic lights: here turn sharp left into Via De Marini and stop in the proximity of the CNR building (which you’ll see to your left, at no. 6 Via De Marini). Report to the reception desk on the ground floor. Alternatively, after the U-turn, you can drive into the CNR underground car park which is immediately past the ERG petrol station.
- If in doubt at any stage, ask directions for SAN BENIGNO or VIA DE MARINI.
